



## **CATALOGUER (Temporary, Full-Time)**

Peace Library System (PLS) is seeking a library technician to work in the Technical Services Department. This is a term position ending January 31, 2020.

Reporting to the IT and Technical Services Manager, this position will be responsible for cataloguing materials for both schools and public libraries. This position also includes training in additional areas of the Technical Services Department to ensure efficient and effective delivery of library services.

### **Primary Responsibilities:**

- Cataloguing new and donated materials (including books, audio-visual media, and digital media) using imported records, customizing existing records, and creating new records
- Processing items and readying them for delivery to libraries
- Assisting other areas of Technical Services as required

- Knowledge of MARC, RDA, DDC, LCSH
- Experience working with an ILS, preferably Polaris
- Strong computer skills related to word processing, record keeping, and in the use of the internet
- Ability to prioritize tasks

- Ability to catalogue in French an asset
