Register your library for CELALibrary.ca

In order to register your patrons for CELA service, your library will first need to create a login identity on registration.celalibrary.ca. You will use your existing CNIB Library Interlibrary Loan account number (6 digits) as your "Username". If you do not know your library's ILL account number, please call (1-855-655-2273, press 2) or [email us](#). We recommend you [create a login identity now](#) so you will be ready to register your patrons with print disabilities. Please note this step is separate from the CELA registration email address we previously requested.

CNIB client registration

As mentioned in our messages in March, we will begin to forward the names of CNIB clients in your area who wish to receive library services. We ask that you contact these clients to sign them up for a library card, describe your local services and, using the [online register form](#) (you must be logged in to see the form), register them for CELA. When you hit the submit button, the

form comes to CELA and a patron account is created. Service should start in five business days.

No fees for deposit collections

We are pleased to confirm that deposit collections of DAISY audio books will continue to be offered for free in funded provinces or libraries.
