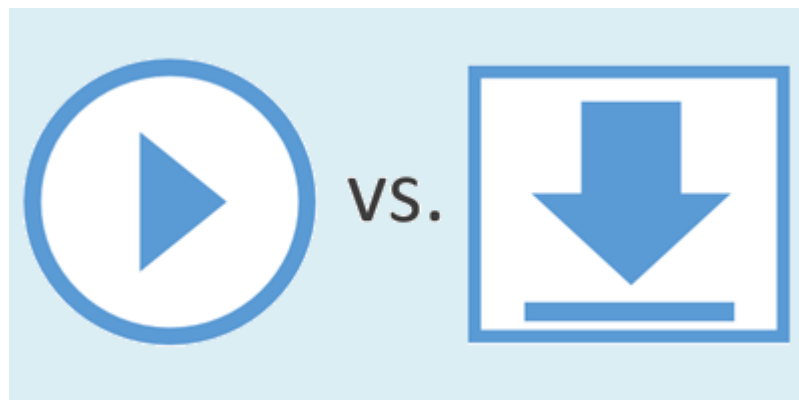

What's the difference?

Streaming is when you are given temporary access to a book, song or movie using your computer or mobile device. Streaming **does not** take up space on your device **but** you have to remain connected to the internet for access. When you disconnect from the internet, the content is **no longer** available to you. Most resources that do this require you to download an app on your mobile device. All of the apps required for the resources we offer are free from an Android and/or Apple app store.

Downloading is when you add a book, song or movie onto your device so you can use it when you are disconnected from the internet. Downloading **does** take up space on your device **but** allows you to use content when you are disconnected. Most resources that do this require you to download an app on your mobile device.
