## Definitions

Continuing Education includes conferences, workshops, courses and area forums held in Alberta and elsewhere. It also includes memberships in professional organizations.

## Guidelines

Board Development Workshops may be held at regular Peace Library System meetings and at other times as scheduled by the Board.

Peace Library System board member(s) may be sent to trustee workshops and conferences. The number to attend will be dependent upon budgeted funds available that year. Preference will be given to board members who have not attended a conference in the previous or current year.

At the discretion of the Executive Committee, PLS will fund travel costs, registration, and accommodation for up to five board members, including the Chair, may to attend the Alberta Library Conference a multi-system or other large library conference in Alberta. and

At the discretion of the Executive Committee, PLS will fund travel costs, registration and accommodation for up to five board members, including the Chair, may attend to attend the Rural Libraries Conference the professional development events put on for the Peace Library System.

Subject to budget restrictions and Association subsidies, the Peace Library System will pay for the registration, accommodation and travel costs for attendance at workshops and conferences.

The System will remain a member in good standing of the Alberta Library Trustees Association (ALTA), and the Library Association of Alberta (LAA). The System will remain a member in good standing of any relevant professional associations deemed helpful to the System.
