JYX FF-S8-T Karaoke Machine

Notes:

- 3 X Microphones included
- **Center Dial** - Main Volume Control (includes mic and song volume)
- **Left Dial** - adjust how much echo the microphones have
- **Right Dial** - adjust volume of microphones without adjusting song volume
- LED Lights can be turned ON or OFF
- Switch Power OFF on machine and microphones when done using
- Plug charging cable into wall and charging input to charge machine



To connect Mics:

1. Insert 2 X AA Batteries into bottom of microphones
2. Turn the microphone switch **On** and it will automatically connect to machine

To use USB or Micro SD Card:

1. Insert USB or Micro SD Card into respective slot and turn on machine
2. Press **MODE/REPEAT** button until LED Screen says **LINE**
3. Press play (on machine or remote) to start song files (.MP3s)
4. Use arrows to skip songs

To use Bluetooth:

1. Turn on machine
2. Press **MODE/REPEAT** button until LED Screen says **BT**
3. Open your Bluetooth settings on your phone/tablet/laptop
4. Find and connect to **FF-S8-T**
5. Any songs/Youtube videos you choose will now play through speaker

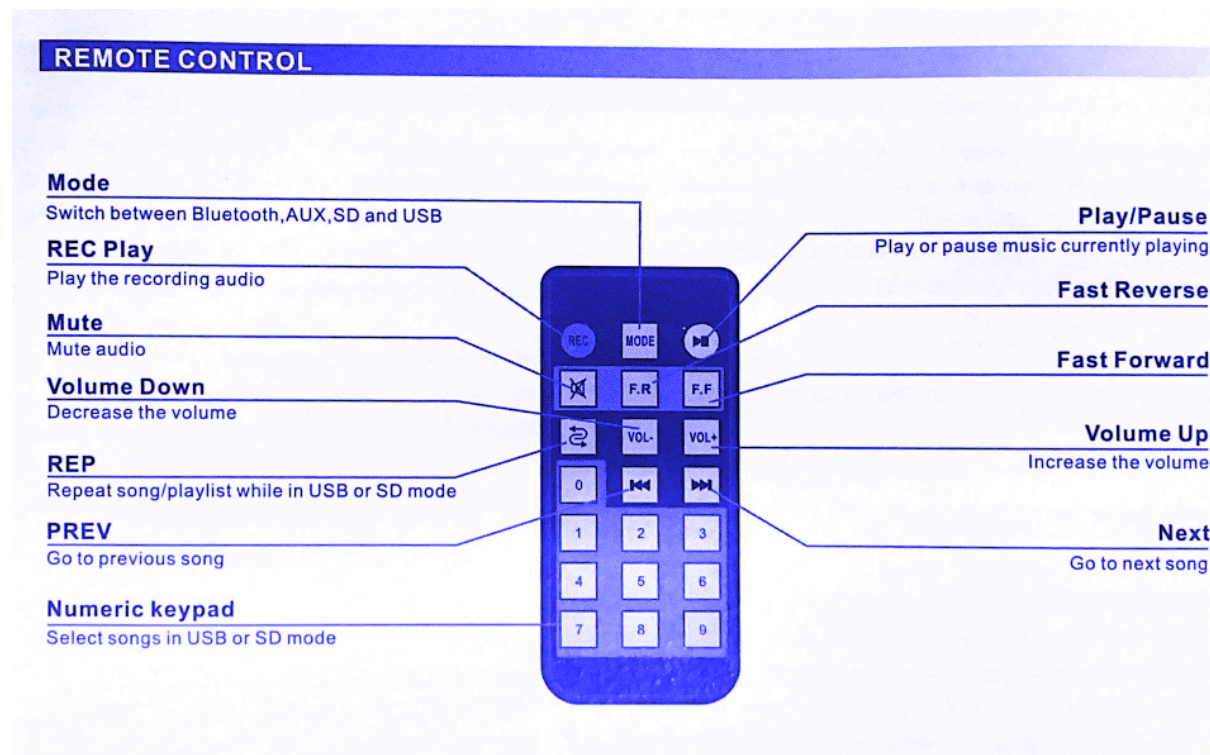

To play music from Smart TV (Youtube):

1. Plug In RCA Male to Male Audio Cable Cord into TV
 - a. Red to Red, White to White
2. Plug other end of cable cord into **AUX-IN** in machine
3. Any sound coming from TV will now port through the machine

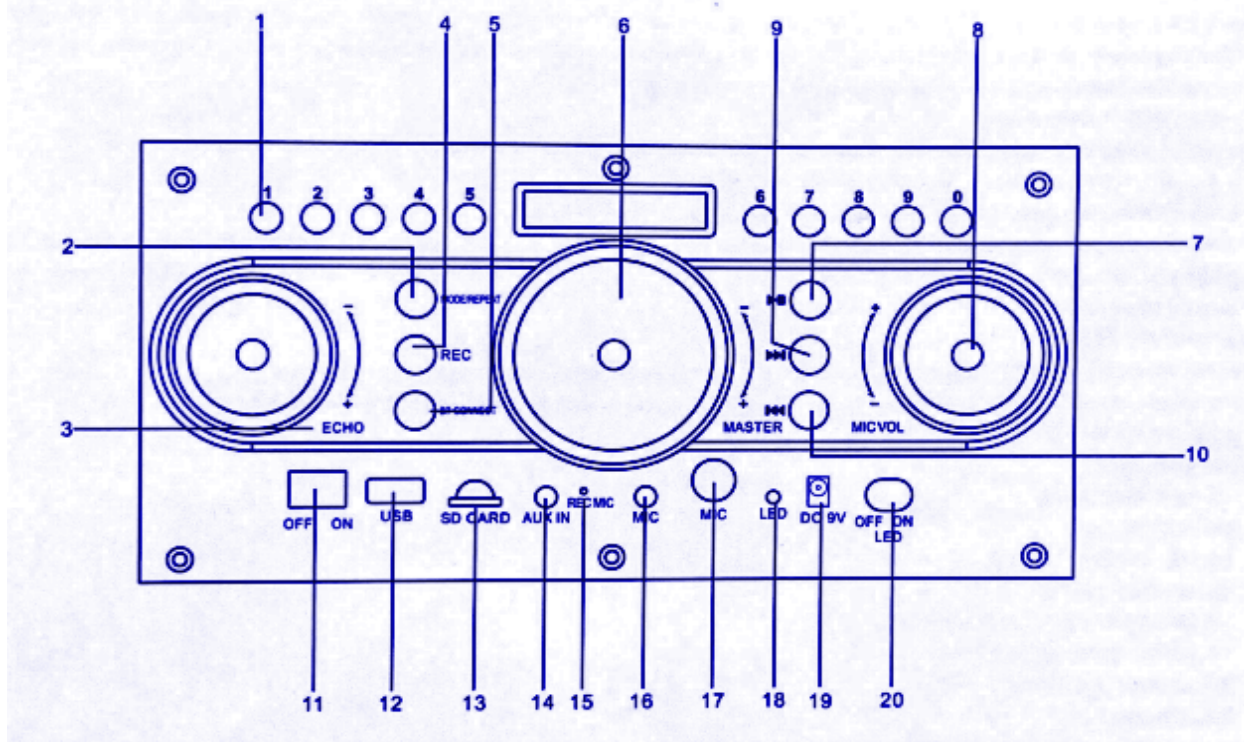
To play music from Phone/Tablet/Laptop (Youtube):

1. Plug in 3.5mm Male to Male Audio Cable into headphone jack of Phone/Tablet/Laptop
2. Plug other end of cable into AUX-IN in machine
3. Any sound coming from Phone/Tablet/Laptop will now port through machine

Button Functions

1. Number Keys
2. Mode/Repeat Key
3. Echo
4. REC: press this key to enter recording state, press again to exit and save the current recording. Need USB or SD Card to record.
5. Bluetooth
6. Master Volume
7. Play/Pause: use with USB or SD Card
8. Mic Volume
9. Next: use with USB or SD Card
10. Previous: use with USB or SD Card
11. Power On / Off
12. USB Jack
13. SD Card Jack
14. AUX-IN Jack
15. Recording Port
16. Microphone Port
17. Microphone Jack
18. Charging Indicator: **Red** while charging, **Blue** when done
19. Charging Input
20. LED Switch On / Off

Laser Magic Ball

Notes:

- This product is a class IIIR laser product. **Users should avoid staring at lasers coming from hole position. May cause eye discomfort.**
- Do not allow children to operate laser machine alone.
- Laser machine is suitable for indoor use. Protection level is IP20. Avoid use in wet, hot, and dusty environments.
- Please use power adapter provided and not an external one.
- Comes with 2 X Screws and a bracket to help attach or hang it on a wall or ceiling



To Use:

1. Plug in power adapter into wall plug and laser machine.
**Can also use the USB adapter to plug machine into a USB port*
2. Lasers will automatically start once plugged in
3. Use the remote to **pause** lights, and turn them **On / Off**

Introduction of remote control function

ON/OFF	ON/OFF
LED	Turn on the LED light only
LASER	Turn on the laser pattern light only
A1	LED and laser light change color by rotation
A2	LED change color by rotation, while laser light is always on
A3	laser light change color by rotation, while LED is always on
FLASH	Flash: LED and laser light flash
Music 1	Light closure sound control: The lights are not bright when there is no sound, LED and laser light flash and change color when there is a sound.
Music 2	Dynamic sound control: The lights are bright Automatically when there is no sound, LED and laser light fast color change when there is a sound.
Music 3	Flash sound control: The Motor stop,LED and laser light change color slowly when there is no sound; The Motor rotation, LED flashing color change, and laser light fast color change, when there is a sound.
PAUSE	Pause: The Motor stop

Class 3R Laser Safety Information

What is a Class 3R Laser?

Class 3R lasers are considered safe when handled carefully. There is only a small hazard potential for accidental exposure. For visible-light lasers, Class 3R lasers' output power is between 1 and 4.99 milliwatts.

In the United States, both Class 2 and 3R lasers can be sold as "pointers" or for pointing purposes. (In Australia, the U.K., and many other countries, laser pointers are restricted to Class 2 only.)

Class 3R is essentially the same as the Roman numeral "Class IIIa" you may see on some lasers' labels.

Safe Use Guidance - General

A Class 3R laser is low powered. It normally would not harm eyes during a momentary exposure of less than ¼ second. This is within the aversion response, where a person turns away and/or blinks to avoid bright light.

Do not deliberately look or stare into the laser beam. Laser protective eyewear is normally not necessary. A Class 3R laser is not a skin or materials burn hazard.

However, a Class 3R laser can be a distraction, glare or flashblindness hazard for pilots and drivers. **NEVER aim any laser towards an aircraft or vehicle that is in motion.** This is unsafe and is illegal -- you could be arrested and jailed.

ONLY ALLOW USE BY RESPONSIBLE PERSONS

This is not a toy. Children can safely use Class 3R lasers only with continuous adult supervision.
