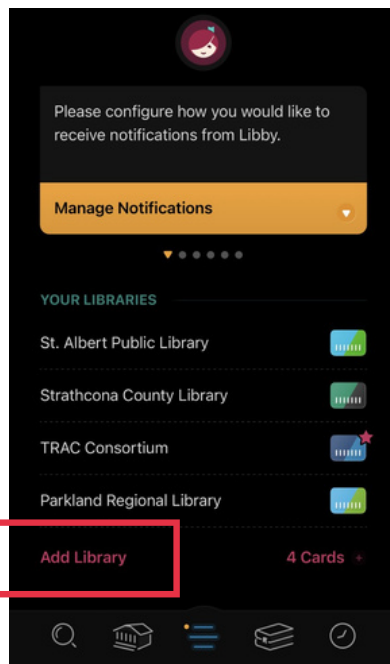


Libby App (IOS and Android)

To access PRLS's OverDrive collection on the Libby app:

1. Tap the Libby icon at the bottom center of any page
2. Tap the **Add Library** button, located under the **Your Libraries** title
3. Search **Parkland Regional Library** and tap when found
4. Tap **Enter Library Account Details**
5. Sign in with your **TRAC library card number and pin**
6. You are now free to search, borrow from, and place holds on PRLS OverDrive items in Libby

Checkouts and Holds from both TRAC and PRLS will appear on your Shelf

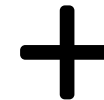

The Regional Automation Consortium's (TRAC) resource licensing agreement with Parkland Regional Library System (PRLS)

What is it?

TRAC and PRLS have agreed on a reciprocal lending agreement for use with OverDrive materials.

With a TRAC library card, you now have access to OverDrive ebooks and digital audiobooks from PRLS.

Why?

This agreement increases the number of titles that TRAC card members have access to.

If the title you are looking for is currently checked out or not in the TRAC collection, you may now search and borrow titles from the PRLS collection.

How?

The PRLS collection can be accessed three different ways:

- OverDrive [Website](#)
- OverDrive App [IOS](#) / [Android](#)
- Libby App [IOS](#) / [Android](#)

The PRLS collection must be searched separately from the TRAC collection. You can do this using the same TRAC OverDrive website and apps.

Number of titles? For how long?

Checkout and hold limits apply only to the library being used. Titles borrowed from PRLS do not count against the checkout limit imposed by TRAC, and TRAC titles borrowed do not count against PRLS's checkout limit.

TRAC Checkout limit: 10 titles at a time

PRLS Checkout limit: 10 titles at a time

The system gives preference to patrons whose home library card matches the OverDrive library being used.

Restrictions?

Certain collections, including simultaneous use items like magazines, may not be lent outside of the home network due to agreements with publishers.

When recommending titles, please do so within your home library's OverDrive site.

OverDrive Website

To access PRLS's OverDrive collection:

1. Go to TRAC's OverDrive home page
2. Click on the **Partner Libraries** link at the top of the page and choose **Parkland Regional Library**
3. Once on PRLS's OverDrive site, sign in with your **TRAC library card number and pin**
4. You are now free to search and borrow from the PRLS OverDrive collection
