

Tips & Tricks for the Nintendo Switch Game Console

- If you need help getting the console hooked up, check out the Nintendo Switch support site or head over the YouTube to find videos like “Nintendo Switch unboxing and how to set up” from Tech Advisor (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qkbRP-i-kCQ>)
- The Nintendo Switch Parental Controls app imposes some restrictions on the console. Contact Duncan Lotoski (dlotoski@peacelibrarysystem.ab.ca) if you need a game whitelisted or edits to the restrictions.
- Before physically removing a game cartridge from the console, make sure to select “Close Software” first.
- The joy cons (controllers) charge when connected to the physical console while the physical console is on the dock.
- To change the orientation of the controllers, select “Controllers” on the home screen.
- We recommend anyone playing on the console use the wrist straps on the controllers. This will avoid any accidental throwing of the controllers. Peace Library System is not responsible for damage caused by patrons playing.
- Do not leave the console unattended.
- Keep track of all the pieces. This console is mobile friendly and has smaller pieces such as the controllers. Things can easily be hidden or fall between furniture.
